Before you use our products and services, please be sure to read and understand this policy carefully, especially the terms and conditions highlighted in bold type or bold underlined type. Please make sure you fully understand and agree such terms and conditions before starting to use. We try to provide you with explanations of technical terms in this policy in a concise and plain way.

Using the information below, we want to inform you about the processing of your Personal Data when you visit our Website. As a PRC company, we observe applicable laws and regulations, particularly the Personal Information Protection Law (Effective on November 1).

By using our Website, you consent to the collection, use, processing and disclosure of your Personal Data in accordance with this Privacy Statement. We have the right to amend, update, revise or change this Privacy Statement (or any part thereof) from time to time. If you do not agree to any part of this Privacy Statement, kindly cease accessing the Website.

We will reply to your request within 15 days. If you are not satisfied with our reply, especially if you think that our processing of personal information has damaged your legal rights and interests, you may also seek solutions by initiating legal proceedings in the court of competent jurisdiction of the place where the defendant is domiciled.

2. Processing of Personal Data when visiting our Website

Personal Data refers to data, whether true or not, about an individual who can be identified directly from that data; or indirectly from that data and other information to which an organisation has or is likely to have access (e.g. name, work address, function, title, e-mail address, phone/mobile number and account details) (collectively referred to as "Personal Data").

When you browse our Website for information purposes (i.e. when you do not register an account or otherwise submit any information to us), we collect your usage data which is gathered by the web analysis services used by us, like HubSpot and Matomo. You can find more information about this, in Point 6 below.

Apart from the use of our Website for purely information purposes, we offer different services which you can use if you are interested and for which you have the personal option to voluntarily disclose your Personal Data in order to utilise our services. More information can be found in the Points below.

3. Why We Collect Personal Data

3.1 We may use your Personal Data or information for any of the following purposes:

- to enable you and us to customize or personalize your experience of our website;
- to enable you to access and use our website, associated applications and associated social media platforms;
- to contact and communicate with you;
- for internal record keeping and administrative purposes;
- for analytics, market research and business development, including to operate and improve our website, associated applications and associated social media platforms;
- to run campaigns and/or offer additional benefits to you;
- for advertising and marketing, including to send you promotional information about our products and services and information about third parties that we consider may be of interest to you;
- to solicit your opinion or feedback on products and/or services provided;
- to manage your newsletter subscriptions; and
- to comply with our legal obligations and resolve any disputes that we may have.

4. Disclosure of your Personal Data

We may disclose your Personal Data or information to the following entities only to the extent the same is required for us to provide you services on our behalf:

4.1 Affiliates

Balluff GmbH and its family of companies. **This may include the transmission of your Personal Data to servers out of PRC and disclosure of your Personal Data in other countries than PRC.** When we transfer your personal data to other countries/regions, we will evaluate and protect that the personal data as described in this statement or as otherwise disclosed to you at the time the data is collected (e.g. via privacy notice or supplementary statement of specific product or service).

4.2 Business Partners

We also may disclose your information to entities that provide services for or on behalf of us, such as companies that run service centres, maintain this Website, to perform data integrity checks, to provide website optimisation services, to deliver advertisements on this Website, to send mail or email, and/or to provide customer service. These entities are limited in their ability to use your information for purposes other than providing services for us and are required by contract to use any information we share with them only to perform services to us or on our behalf and to protect the confidentiality of your Personal Data or information.

4.3 Other Parties

There may be instances when we disclose your information to other parties:

- to comply with the law or respond to compulsory legal process (e.g. court orders or enforcement authorities);
- to verify or enforce compliance with the applicable laws and regulations;
- to protect our rights and property or any of our respective affiliates, business partners, or customers to the extent permitted by law;
- as part of a merger or transfer, or in the event of a bankruptcy when purpose of data collection remains unchanged;
- when you consent to or request such sharing; and
- when we anonymize the data.

When we disclose your Personal Data to our affiliates, business partners, and other parties, this will mean that your Personal Data may be transferred to countries outside PRC, which have no comparable level of data protection so that an appropriate protection level is not guaranteed.

If this is the case, we ensure that data protection is sufficiently guaranteed. This is possible through binding company rules, standard contractual terms on the protection of personal data, certificates, or recognized codes of conduct. Please note that particularly in the case of transmission to the USA there is a risk that your data may be processed by US authorities for control and monitoring purposes. 5. Use of Cookies

Cookies are required to use the Balluff website. A cookie is a small file that can be stored on your computer when you visit a website. Every time you load our website, your browser checks if a cookie associated with our website exists (i.e. contains the name of our website). If it does, your browser sends the information saved in this cookie back to our website. This allows our website to recognize that it had already been opened in this browser before, and some of the displayed content may vary based on this information.

Cookies are generally stored in order to optimize and personalize page design, offer users additional features, increase loading speed, and for statistical purposes. With the use of cookies, we furthermore can offer you products and services that we think may be of interest to you. You can block or delete the cookies from this site. However, this action can prevent some of the website features from working properly.

Please note: None of the cookies used on our website collect information that can be used to identify you personally.

You can block or delete cookies in the browser settings. In order to manage cookies, most browsers allow you to accept or reject all cookies, or to accept only specific types of cookies. You can also adjust your settings so you will be asked every time a website wants to store a cookie. The ways in which you can specifically manage and delete cookies depend on your particular browser. Every browser differs in this respect. - persistent cookies (see 5.2)

5.1 Transient cookies

Transient cookies are automatically deleted when you close the browser. They include, in particular, session cookies. They save a session ID which can be used to assign different queries from your browser to the joint session. As a result, your computer can be recognized when you return to our website. The session cookies are deleted when you log out or close the browser.

5.2 Persistent cookies

Persistent cookies are automatically deleted after a specified time which may vary depending on the cookie. You can delete the cookies in the security settings of your browser at any time.

You can configure your browser setting according to your wishes and refuse the acceptance of third-party cookies or all cookies. Click on the 'HELP' feature in your browser if you want to find out more about this.

Please note that you may not be able to use all features on the Website if you block or delete cookies.

We use cookies in order to be able to identify you for subsequent visits if you have an account with us. Otherwise, you have to log in each time you visit our Website.

The flash cookies used are not collected by your browser, but by your flash plug-in. We also use HTML5 storage objects that are placed on your end device. These objects store the necessary data irrespective of the browser used by you and have no automatic expiration date. If you do not want to allow the processing of flash cookies, you have to install a corresponding add-on, e.g. BetterPrivacy for Mozilla Firefox or the Adobe Flash Killer Cookie for Google Chrome. Necessary Cookies

These cookies are necessary for the operation of the site. They help to make the website usable and enable security-relevant functionalities. Without these cookies the website cannot function properly.

We use the HubSpot marketing automation software of the American company HubSpot Inc., 2nd Floor 30 North Wall Quay, Dublin 1, Ireland (hereinafter referred to as "HubSpot") for both our website www.balluff.com.cn, our blog blog.innovatingautomation.asia/ and our knowledge base kb.innovatingautomation.asia/. HubSpot is an integrated software solution by which we cover different aspects of our digital marketing, sales, and customer relation management. Furthermore, we use the tool for analytical purposes of our web offer to optimize it and to offer you the best possible and user-friendly service. We use HubSpot for:

- Contacting us through the contact form or live-chat box
- Sending newsletters
- Content management for our blog
- Subscription to blog updates
- Creating landing pages which are used as part of an advertising campaign and contain interaction possibilities such as contacting or download of white papers
- Social media linking and social media sharing
- Evaluating the usage of our web pages (e.g. access, pages visited, dwelling time, etc.) as well as for evaluating the usage of our newsletter (opening rate, click rate, unsubscribe, etc.)

Your personal data which you provide, e.g. when using our contact form, live chat or download form, are stored on the servers of our software and hosting partner HubSpot in the USA.

Please note that particularly in the case of transmission to the USA there is a risk that your data may be processed by US authorities for control and monitoring purposes. But we will request your consent to cross border transfer of personal sensitive data or enforce data anonymization before crossing border.

Of course, HubSpot also uses "cookies" which are saved on your computer and allow us to analyse your usage of the website. The information gathered (e.g. IP address, **geographical location**, type of browser, duration of the visit and **pages viewed**) is evaluated by HubSpot on our behalf so that we can generate reports on the visit and the pages viewed and can therefore improve our online presence. Technical data collected:

- IP address, Time of subscription and webform used for the subscription.

6.3 Newsletters

To keep you up to date about our company and products, we offer newsletters to different topics:

- Service E-Mails
- Industry News
- Balluff News (Company/ Marketing/ Application/ Products)
- Innovating Automation News
- Sales and Offer Emails
- Blog News

Only your e-mail address is required for sending the newsletters. **The disclosure of other, separately marked data is voluntary and is used to be able to address you personally.**

You may revoke your consent at any time. This can be done by clicking on the link in every newsletter e-mail or sending an e-mail to DP.APAC@Balluff.com.

For sending the newsletter we make use of HubSpot, who has been bound by us to comply with the PRC data protection laws. Our e-mail newsletters may contain links which lead you to special Balluff websites. In this way we can measure the effectiveness of marketing initiatives. The newsletters may also contain links to third-party websites. After you unsubscribe, we shall block your data given in this context so that you no longer receive any newsletters from us in the future.

6.4 Netigate

After the checkout we conduct an anonymous survey. This can be completed on a voluntary basis. You have the right to refuse or withdraw your consent at any time by contacting us. Please note that if you choose to refuse or withdraw your consent, we might not be able to provide you with relevant services. After the checkout we will conduct an anonymous survey which is to be completed on a voluntary basis. This survey includes a satisfaction rating and a comments section. The aim is to further develop the online shop and improve customer satisfaction.

6.5 Live Chat

If you want to receive direct information or help on our products, services, or other information about Balluff, you have the option to contact us directly and quickly via the Chat feature on our Website (at certain times). To take part in the live chat, we require your name, e-mail address and job function. **If you share other Personal Data with us during the live chat, this information is provided on a voluntary basis.**

6.6 Analytical data and reporting

Using HubSpot we can carry out the following analytical collections and evaluations, among other things:

- Activity on our web pages and our blog
- Number of page views and dwelling time of website visitor
- Click path of the respective visitor
- Downloads of files provided via the website
- Visits to landing pages
- Opening rates of e-mails from newsletters and campaigns

By using the website or blog you declare your consent to the collection of analytical data. You can always unsubscribe from the HubSpot tracking using the opt-out button in the cookie message.

6.7 HubSpot logfiles

Whenever calling up websites/landing pages created using HubSpot, HubSpot automatically generates so-called logfiles. Among other things, the logfiles can contain the following information: **IP address, browser type, domain names, internet service provider (ISP), the files viewed on our site (e.g., HTML pages, graphics, etc.), operating system, clickstream data, access times and referring website addresses.** This information is used by HubSpot to provide general statistics regarding use of the Websites. For these purposes, **we do link this automatically-collected data to other Personal Information such as name, email address, address, and phone number.**

We use Parlay (iClick Data Technology (Beijing) Ltd) to integrate personal information from Wechat subscribers in Hubspot.

7. Use of Matomo

This website uses the web analysis service software Matomo (www.matomo.org), a service provided by InnoCraft Ltd., 150 Willis St, 6011 Wellington, New Zealand, to collect and store data on the basis of our legitimate interest in statistically analyzing user behavior for optimization and marketing purposes. This data may be used to create and analyze pseudonymous user profiles for the same purpose. Cookies may be used for this purpose. Cookies are small text files that are stored locally in the buffer of the page visitor's web browser. Among other things, cookies make it possible to recognize the web browser. The data collected using Matomo's technology (including your pseudonymized IP address) is processed on our servers. The information generated by the cookie in the pseudonymous user profile is not used to personally identify the visitor to this website and is not combined with any Personal Data about the bearer of the pseudonym. You can configure your browser settings according to your wishes and refuse the acceptance of such cookie.

8. Other features and offers of our Website

8.1 Use of our Online Shop

When you use our online shop, we process your data within the scope of the order process and for the purpose of performance of the contract concluded between us. For this purpose, we process the following types of data provided to us by you:

- Your e-mail address;
- Your department and company's industry

The ordering process is encrypted using SSL technology to prevent unauthorized access by third parties to your personal data. In order to fulfil the contractual obligations, we share your data that are necessary to deliver your order with delivery suppliers.

You can voluntarily create a customer account via which we can save your data for further purchases. When creating an account, the data specified by you is saved until further notice. You can always correct the erroneous data or delete your data that we are not under a legal obligation to store in the customer area. After the checkout we conduct an anonymous survey. This can be completed on a voluntary basis. No personal data is processed. This survey includes a satisfaction rating and a comments section. The aim is to further develop the online shop and improve customer satisfaction.
